1. Discussion Item: Institutional AI Policy Alignment

Background

University leadership encourages AI integration, yet some faculty discourage or penalize AI use. CSU-level syllabus guidance exists but may not be consistently implemented. Faculty/Student concerns include:

- AI inaccuracies (Dheeraj)
- Discipline-specific limitations (Laura)

Discussion Questions

- What is SJSU's official AI policy?
- Is there misalignment between presidential messaging and faculty enforcement?
- Should AI usage be department-specific?
- Should AS draft a formal resolution on AI?

Potential Actions

- Request Academic Senate clarification on AI policy.
- Draft an AS Academic Affairs AI Resolution.
- Recommend standardized CSU-compliant syllabus language.
- Develop guiding principles (e.g., transparency, academic integrity, discipline-specific flexibility).

2. Discussion Item: AI Detection Tools & Data Privacy Concerns

Background

SJSU has partnered with Turnitin. Some faculty reportedly use external AI-detection platforms not affiliated with SJSU. Disclosure practices vary across syllabi.

Discussion Questions

- Are faculty permitted to upload student work to third-party tools not approved by SJSU?
- Are there FERPA or data privacy implications?
- Should AI detection tool usage be standardized?
- Should syllabus disclosure be mandatory?

Potential Actions

- Request clarification from IT and Academic Technology.
- Recommend standardized syllabus language regarding AI tools.
- Review compliance with CSU data governance policies.
