- 3. Reflect on your experience writing an op-ed piece using AI tools.
- 4. Think about how you might ethically and productively integrate some of those AI tools and experiences into your course and assignments.
- 5. Revise your syllabus and assignment sheets.
- 6. Submit your revised syllabus and assignment sheets for sharing on the WAC website.
